EAGLESTONE BELGIUM DELIVERS "K-NOPY" TO THE STATE OF THE NETHERLANDS



Designed by the architectural firm Axent, K-Nopy embodies architectural excellence and boldness, core values of Eaglestone Belgium. The building's envelope, made of architectonic concrete, is a testament to meticulous architecture, perfectly integrated into the heart of the European Quarter. This urban redevelopment harmonises with the surrounding offices and the more residential areas of Rue de Toulouse


The K-Nopy's ground floor features refined reception areas, showcasing unique finishes and materials chosen for their elegance and character. Inspired by Dutch heritage, these choices add a subtle touch and enrich the building with a cultural dimension.




A BUILDING COMBINING SUSTAINABILITY AND CREATIVITY

K-Nopy stands out for its sustainable conception, which does not rely on fossil fuels and is faithful to Eaglestone's values in terms of environmental responsibility. The building is BREEAM Outstanding certified, thanks to in-depth studies covering natural light, thermal comfort and consumption analysis. The intensive green roofs and photovoltaic panels integrated into the rooftop are further evidence of a more sustainable architecture.

A re-use approach has been integrated into the project, notably for the terrace coverings (taken from pontoons in a port), the false floors, the light fittings and some of the sanitary fittings. This approach also helps to limit the building's environmental footprint.

In addition, the State of the Netherlands will integrate works of art by Dutch artists, adding an enriching artistic touch to K-Nopy. This highlights the design of the building and enhances the local heritage, while reflecting Eaglestone's passion for art.
